LETTERS TO THE EDITOR

In all newspapers, there is an opinion or editorial page where readers are encouraged to express their thoughts. In addition to articles from our regular columnists and an occasional editorial written by one of our publishers, *The Plaquemines Gazette* accepts letters from the public addressed to the editor.

Letters could be sent in to raise concerns, give opinions on different matters of public interest, or recognize and appreciate the good works of individuals and organizations. Letters to newspapers are a reflection on society and an excellent way to let elected government officials understand how their constituents feel. If drafted correctly, these letters can be a powerful tool for influencing change in society.

The most effective letters to newspapers are short, specific, and factual. Focus your letter on one main concept and try to get your point across well. Be polite, calm, and use humor where appropriate. Be certain that any information that you have provided is accurate and verifiable.

Here is our "Letter to the Editor" Policy:

- The maximum length for letters is 500 words.
- Letters must be submitted by 5 p.m. on Wednesdays.
- All letters must be signed by an individual. An individual's name may be withheld if the newspaper believes the content of the letter is beneficial to our readers and publishing the writer's name may cause harm, however the letter must still be signed. Letters submitted by an organization must still have an individual's signature.
- Letters submissions should include your full name, city
 of residence and phone number for us to reach you. Your
 phone number will not be printed in the newspaper with
 your letter.
- Letters should be on one subject/topic each. Photos may accompany the letter but will be published at the discretion of the newspaper.
- One letter from an individual or organization is allowed in a six-week time span.
- Letters from candidates seeking election to public office must be a paid advertisement.
- Letters are subject to editing for clarity, length and accuracy.
- Newspaper management maintains the right to refuse the publication of any letter it deems inappropriate for its readers.
